Andreas C. Kramvis
Vice Chairman, Honeywell

Andreas C. Kramvis was appointed in March 2014 as Vice Chairman of Honeywell International (NYSE: Hon) a Fortune 100 multi-industry company with annual sales of \$40 billion.

Prior to his current role, Andreas was President and CEO of Honeywell Performance Materials and Technologies, a business group that he guided to leadership positions in high technology specialty chemicals, refrigerants, petrochemical and refining technologies, and gas processing with financial performance at the very top of the chemical industry. From 2002 to 2007, Andreas led a major transformation of Honeywell's Environmental and Combustion Controls global business, where he achieved major increases in market share and established strong profitability.

Andreas joined Honeywell through the acquisition of Pittway; in his 12 years with Pittway, he was a key member of the team that took that company from \$200 million to \$1.6 billion in sales and global leadership in security and fire equipment and achieved compound organic growth of 25% pa over this time.

Between 1984 and 1988, Andreas was an Executive with Combined Technologies, a high technology venture incubator Company, which took two start-up Companies in information technology public on the London Stock Exchange. He began his career at Cadbury Schweppes in London in finance and soon moved into General Management, running his first company at age 26.

Andreas moved to USA in 1984. He grew up in Cyprus and attended the English School, Nicosia and Sevenoaks School in Kent, England, where he was on OPOS scholar. He studied Engineering at Cambridge University, specializing in Electronics. He holds an M.B.A. from Manchester Business School where he was the Conoco scholar. He is the author of a book titled Transforming the Corporation: Running a Business in the 21st Century, which encapsulates his proven methodology of achieving spectacular performance improvements in businesses.

Andreas is a past Chairman of the Society of Chemical Industry (SCI), a Board Member and Executive Committee Member of the American Chemistry Council, a Director of Aptar (NYSE :ATR) and a Director of Axalta Coating Systems (NYSE: AXTA).

Andreas is married to Shirley, whom he met at Cambridge, and they have three children. He is an avid tennis player and a poor golfer.
